OFFICE ORDER

The Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi in its 155th Board Meeting has revised the monitoring protocol in fulfillment of the Notification Dated 17.06.2005 on "Uniform Protocol on Water Quality Monitoring Order 2005" notified by MoEF. The River Monitoring for surface water samples under NWMP (MINARS) shall be carried out on **monthly** basis and sampling of Ground Water points, State Water Monitoring Points shall be done as per previous practices i.e. half yearly and quarterly respectively. No separate orders shall be issued from the Head Office in future. All laboratories in-charge are directed to carry out the analysis strictly as per decision/ directions of CPCB in its 155th Board meeting held on 28.06.2010 and in compliance to the Notification Dated 17.06.2005 on "Uniform Protocol on Water Quality Monitoring Order 2005" and Notes given below. The samples shall be collected as per detail of location and frequency attached. The following Officers/ Officials are hereby deputed to conduct the River Monitoring Programme:-

- NOTE - I All the Group in charge will collect the river monitoring kit in advance from concerned laboratories of the State Board so that sampling could be done as per schedule.
- NOTE - II The duty of Helpers /Peons are to be ordered by the Group Incharge of the Sampling Team as per suitability and their availability during the sampling.
- NOTE -III No separate orders shall be issued from Head Office and all the Officials, Helpers/Peons are directed for strict compliance of duty as per schedule finalized by Group Incharge and non compliance shall be viewed seriously.
- NOTE -IV All the Officials /Helpers/ Peons are directed to handover the samples to the Laboratory Incharge of the Laboratory at Parwanoo, Jassur, Paonta, Sunder Nagar and obtain receipt bearing date and time of handling over the samples. The receipt should be attached with the T.A. Bill after getting certificate from team head.
- NOTE -V All the Officers/ Officials are directed not to sanction the leave of Officials/ Peon/ Helper during the monitoring Programme.
- NOTE -VI Samples of Bio-Monitoring shall be collected at all points monitored under NWMP (MINARS) Programme.
- NOTE -VII The analysis of the samples shall be carried out strictly as per Uniform Protocol on Water Quality monitoring Order 2005 & Revised monitoring Protocol. The sample analysis results shall be forwarded/ submitted to this office on prescribed format within 15 days.
- NOTE -VIII The analysis report of the samples collected from and near MSW dump sites may be given to the Sr. Project Consultant HQ, with a copy along State Water Monitoring results to SSO HQ as per previous practice.
- NOTE -IX In case sample could not be taken due to any reason then the concerned team will submit the report of the same and prepare the tour programme for conducting the same within the same month.
- NOTE-X Vehicles attached with the Regional Officers of the Board shall be made available for the monitoring and in case of non availability of Govt. Vehicle taxi may be hired as per rate approved by the Government of Himachal Pradesh.
